
Trips out - a relaxing river cruise from Dapdune Wharf and a visit to the beautiful Lavender Fields

Resident Peter received a special visit from The Lions Club, with a presentation to celebrate his service!







# Cozy Autumn Spice Pumpkin Soup

#### **Ingredients:**

1 Pumpkin (peeled, deseeded & chopped) | 2 tbsp Olive Oil | 1 Medium Onion (chopped) | 3 Garlic Cloves (chopped) | 1 tsp Grated Ginger | 1 tsp Mixed Spice | 600ml Vegetable Stock | 100ml Double Cream | Sea Salt & Black Pepper

#### Method:

- 1. Heat the olive oil in a saucepan and gently fry the chopped onion until soft. Add the chopped garlic and grated ginger and fry for 1 minute.
- 2. Add the chopped pumpkin to the mixture for 10 minutes, stirring occasionally until the pumpkin starts to soften and has a nice golden colour.
- 3. Pour in the vegetable stock, add the mixed spice and bring the mixture to the boil. Then simmer for 20 minutes until the pumpkin is really tender.
- **4.** Blend the soup until smooth. Add the double cream and a little more of the vegetable stock if the soup is on the thick side.
- 5. Taste for seasoning, adding salt and pepper as required. Ladle the soup into a bowl and serve with a swirl of cream.
