





Chicken Caesar Crostini Recipe from Chef Niranjan at Elm Lodge

Ingredients:

1 baguette, 1 chicken breast (cooked and thinly sliced), romaine or cos lettuce (tear into small pieces), grated parmesan cheese, caesar dressing, olive oil, salt & pepper.

Method:

- 1. Cut the baguette into even slices and brush both sides with olive oil.
- 2. Bake in the oven (175°C) for 4 minutes, flip them over and then bake for another 4 minutes until crisp. Remove from the oven and cool for 2 minutes.
- 3. Once cooled, top the crostinis with the torn lettuce, chicken, caesar dressing, grated parmesan cheese and salt & pepper to taste.
